SUMMER JOB – ACTIVITY LEADER (2 POSITIONS)

ElderCare operates recreational Adult Day Programs, supporting those in the community who are experiencing social isolation, cognitive decline, or physical ability decline, and their caregivers. Our programs operate out of local seniors centres, providing a community atmosphere for the clients who are still living in their communities, and opportunities to maintain their social, cognitive, and physical health through recreational programs. The successful candidate will have an opportunity to learn about working with seniors affected by social isolation, dementia, and/or other conditions involved in geriatric supports through recreational day programs. Our program staff are excited to learn, and passionate about supporting a culture that values an accountable and healthy workforce. This position supports a caring environment that is dedicated to supporting the wellness of the families we serve.

Position Description: Reporting to the Program Manager, this position is responsible for supporting the operations our recreational day programs, including:

- Assist in the planning and implementation of recreation programs that include physical, emotional, cognitive, and social programs. (We have fun through crafts, games, and physical activities... If you've never seen a group of seniors play with nerf guns, you're missing out!)
- Provide assistance to clients with meal service and personal care.
- Daily cleaning tasks as required.
- Daily reporting tasks as required.

Term: 9–12 weeks, starting in June or July 2024. (Holidays may be accommodated.)

Wage: \$20/hour

Candidate Requirements:

- between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act [S.C. 2001, c. 27] (International students are not eligible. Recent immigrants are eligible if they are Canadian Citizens or permanent residents.)
- legally entitled to work in Alberta;
- able to produce a satisfactory police & vulnerable sector check prior to the start of employment;
- Standard First Aid & CPR–C certification;
- ideally in an education program related to Recreation Therapy, Geriatrics, Education, Nursing, Social Work, or another related field.
